


# HOUSE OF BIRDS

## CONCEPT

“...Even the height of the “entrance door” is crucial, because different animals prefer different spaces to nest. Just to give you an idea: the swallow prefers a hole 4 cm wide, placed at 13 cm in height, the wren 2.5 cm hole in width and 13 cm in height, the blackcap 2.8 cm in width and 18 cm in height, the woodpecker 3.5 cm in width and 18 cm in height, the chaffinch 4 cm in width and 15 cm in height, and so on...”


# CONCEPT

This house can host different species of birds, just choose the proper entrance turning the frontal plate.




